Dr. Dinesh K. Agarwal Director of Innovation, Incubation & Entrepreneurship, KIMSDU, Karad, was invited for the deliverance of this lecture.

Welcome note was given by Ms. Jotsna Gandhi followed by felicitation of the guest lecturer, Dr. D. K. Agarwal at the hands of Respected Dean, Dr. R. C. Doijad Sir. The inaugural address was given by Respected Dr. R. C. Doijad Sir. A pre-test was conducted prior to the lecture to test the knowledge of the topic. In the beginning, Dr. Dinesh K. Agarwal introduced the topic and explained the history and objectives of National Education Policy 2020 to the faculty members. He elaborated on the academic flexibility while implementing NEP 2020 in the context of various academic programs run by KIMSDU. He said that the committee has proposed changes in the curriculum structure and duration of degree programs to ensure seamless student mobility within the university through a formal system of credit recognition, accumulation, transfer and redemption to promote flexibility in the education system. Three combinations were explained to the faculty members which included:

- 1. Entry/exit model for graduate and postgraduate programs
- 2. Integrated undergraduate and postgraduate programs
- 3. Flexibility in registration for PhD programs

At the end, he discussed the salient features of NEP 2020 in brief and ways of their implementation in medical sciences. After an outstanding talk by Dr. D. K. Agarwal Sir, a question-answer session was conducted where the faculty members enthusiastically participated and Dr. Agarwal cleared their doubts.

Before concluding, the post-test and feed-back link was forwarded to the participants. Dr. V. S. Ghorpade delivered the vote of thanks.
