KIP Initiative: “Helping Hands for People Affected by Flood”

Activity Date: 11 and 12th August 2019

Due to heavy rain and flood situation in July and early August 2019, the major districts from Maharashtra State such as Sangli, Satara, and Kolhapur were suffering with tremendous loss. People had lost their hopes and almost everything in the flood.

Krishna Institute of Pharmacy (B. Pharm.), KIMSUDU, Karad came forward to initiate the activity to help those people, and for this, **KIP Initiative: “Helping Hands for People Affected by Flood”** was planned by Krishna Institute of Pharmacy (B. Pharm.) under the guidance and support of Dean, Dr. R. C. Doijad, to help the flood victims and their families.

For this initiative, dean, all the staff members, and students from B. Pharm. donated voluntarily by their own. Around 18,500 Rs. were collected from the donations received. From that donation collected or received, students of KIP purchased and prepared the kits including different types of medicines, daily needed things, and the groceries.






