Mode and Methodology:

In continuation with circular dated 5th Sept. 2020 in regard to conduct for Academic and Administrative Audit for 2019-20, the committee has prepared the report by compiling the data of all the constituent college and visit there to on 7th, 8th, and 9th December and subsequently the report was submitted for its necessary consideration on 11.12.20, in the said report, the committee has considered all criteria parameters up to 30th June 2020 up to which the academic session ends.

With reference to the notification issued by UGC dated 31.12.20 where in the light of pandemic condition the academic session, 2019-20 has been extended till 31st December 2020 and therefore the committee has revisited all metrics criteria wise as per the NAAC format and submitted a separate report as an; extended report for AAA for the academic session 2019-20, in

which the observations are made from July 2020 to 31st December 2020 in continuation with the earlier report. The observations, suggestions of the committee revisit on 20th March are as follows: Committee has observed that deficiency as pointed out by AAA of last academic session are fulfilled up to certain extent, and those are partially or solely not compiled are include by this committee under its observation and suggestion.

Para wise observation/ suggestion for compliance

Criteria 1: Curricular Aspects

- The University should make efforts for increasing the interdisciplinary content in the existing courses in view of new education policy.
- In the same manner, the University should make efforts for making the content of the courses in an interdisciplinary manner.
- An effective system of feedback form all stake holders with the action taken for the better augmentation of different procedures.

Criteria 2: Teaching, Learning and Evaluation

- There is a scope to increase the regional student diversity at national and international level.
- The modern ICT tools can be adopted to make the teaching learning process novel and innovative.

Criteria 3: Research, Innovations and Extension

- The committee has observed a reasonable increment on publication of IPR components that, copyright awarded- 150, patent published- 15, patent granted-4 and design patent granted- 4.
- The committee has also observed a reasonable increment on publication made by faculty and students in indexed journals i.e. 202, from July to December 2020.
- There is a scope to increase in quality of publication made by the faculty and students.
- There is a scope to increase citation index including h- index of the institute.
- The amount of consultancy can be increased by taking much efforts by approaching regional industries and other relevant institution.
- Collaborative research needs to be enhanced.

Criteria 4: Infrastructure and Learning Resources

- Infrastructure and Learning Resources available at the University are seems to be satisfactory with good academic ambience which is spread over the 57 acres of land with high quality maintenance and greenery.
- The infrastructural deficiencies which are depicted by earlier committee shall be fulfilled within a span of 1 month as the construction activities are going on at its optimum level.
- Well-equipped skill lab with different components for skill training of the students on automation and simulation is available however other facility needs to be increase and for imparting the skill training in view of prevailing covid- 19 situation and overall availability of clinical material.


Criteria 5: Student Support and Progression

- The beneficiary students by scholarship/ free ship are observed up to certain extent.
- The student progression in the various competition for admission in higher level education is reasonable good.
- Ramp and lifts are available wherever required for differently abled students.

Criteria 6: Governance, Leadership and Management

- The institution has constituted various cells under the coordinator ship of a senior and qualified faculty those are responsible to relieve the pressure of academic responsibilities of the Deans.
- IQAC is working under the full time Director with its roles and responsibilities as defined by UGC.
- The meetings of all the bodies and authorities like Board of Studies, IQAC, Academic Council, Planning and Monitoring Committee, Finance Committee and Board of Management etc. are conducted regularly in accordance with the governing rules.

- The institution is enriched in adopting many best practices but there is more scope to adopt other practices in the hospital area for internal transport facility to the patients like motorized trolley can be provided for the patients those are severely injured.
- All the committee like anti ragging committee, women empowerment cell etc as defined by the UGC mandate are in function.
- The University has a Cosmo politan ambience where the student diversity among the male and female with different parts of the country are admitted.
- UNESCO Bioethics chair has been created in the University.

Recommendation	Action Taken Report
As the institution is undergoing into the addition of infrastructure construction therefore it will be advisable to allocate the infrastructural facilities to those departments/laboratories where ever the deficiency of infrastructure has been pointed out by this committee as well as by the earlier committee for AAA.	This comment will be taken into consideration and infrastructural facilities will be developed as mentioned in the reports.
Need to develop the virtual courses on governmental portal like SWAYAM and to promote the students to opt the courses for the registration, learning and assessment.	University has identified the faculty members who can design such courses and given the task.
The publications in the quality journals with high Impact factor need to be improved	These recommendations are addressed gradually by the Directorate of Research with the help of Deans of Faculties. substantial amount of increments and other costs are offered to the faculty members. Also initiative of Research Guidance Clinic has been undertaken.
Extramural fund to carry out research need to be increased.	
Clinical trials and collaborative research projects with the governmental agencies need to be strengthened.	
More number of research journals need to be subscribed.

Proper ventilation and illumination to be provided in the dissection hall.	This recommendation was brought in the notice of Civil & Maintenance department for necessary changes.
Dept of Pathology needs to improve in the innovative practices.	The Head of the department is requested to work on this recommendation.
In the KIMS, up keeping of the records in the administration and communication among the office staff, need to be improved.	Dean of Faculty of Medicine is requested to look into this matter and take necessary action.
Lack of infrastructure for artificial reproductive techniques.	The facility for Artificial Reproductive Techniques has not been started yet. The infrastructure will be developed as and when it will start.
